
BLUE LINE ART COMIC BOOK ART BOARDS

The comic book (or graphic novel, as larger works are often called) is a form of sequential art. Sequential art is a type of storytelling that combines words and pictures in a series to tell a story; any kind of story. From super-heroes to real life, there is no limit other than your imagination. Manga is the Japanese term for comics and has its own style and feel, but all of the basics of creating comics are the same in any language!



Pencils

Inks

A plot is a written description in paragraph form of the action that will take place on the page. Some creators draw directly from the plot and add dialogue later.

Script

A script is a complete description of the action on the page, including character dialogue. Working from a full script can help an artist plan to leave enough room for word balloons.

Thumbnails

Thumbnails are very small, very rough sketches that an artist uses to figure out the number of panels on a page and the placement of the characters.

Layouts

Layouts are done on the final art board. They are more detailed than thumbnails but are not finished drawings. They include all of the important storytelling elements.


Pencils

The finished penciled page completes the drawing started in the layouts and adds all important details. Large areas that are to be filled with black are left for the inking stage.

Inking is the art of finishing the comic book page. Inkers go over the initial pencil lines and add shading and depth. Unneeded pencil lines are carefully erased after the ink dries.


Some art is complete at the inked stage. If the page is to be colored you can use colored pencil, markers or scan pages into a computer coloring program.

FULL TRIM COMIC BOOK ART BOARDS 11x17

Blue Line Art's Full Trim Format (11 x17) with a 15 ¾ x 10 3/8 image border with a extra 9 x 13 ¾ safe area dotted border area. This extra proportioned border allows for more freedom and choices when using the board. The border allows the artwork to bleed across so that the final image can be cut down and look fuller. Borders are printed in non-photo blue.
